5. Eligibility :	All CUHK full-time staff (welcome both Men and Women)
6. Enrollment :	(1) Each team consist of 5 to 9 players
	(2) Maximum 8 teams will be accepted on a First-come-first-serve Basis
	(3) Each player represents one team only
7. Game Time :	Two halves of 15 minutes, 30 minutes in total each match (5-minute half-time break)
8. Rules :	(1) Team check-in less than 10 minutes before the game starts will be treated as abstain
