2019-2020 SQUASH OPEN CHAMPIONSHIPS
RULES AND REGULATIONS



- (1) Objectives:** (i) To provide non-University team players competition experience and enhance sharing and friendship.
(ii) To identify potential University team players.
- (2) Date:** Saturday, 28th September 2019.
- (3) Time:** 1:00 pm-6:00pm.
- (4) Venue:** Squash Centre, 1/F Kwok's Sports Building, University Sports Centre.
- (5) Eligibility:** All full-time undergraduates, post-graduates and Teacher's Certificate students (past or current University Squash team players are not allowed to participate).
- (6) Events and Quota:** Men's Singles and Women's Singles, 32 players for each group.
- (7) Rules:** The tournament will be played under the Rules of the World Singles Game.
- (8) Format:** Single elimination. Scoring for matches before the semi-final shall be a point-a-rally basis for one game being played to 15 points. However, if the score reaches 14-all – tiebreaker, player to win by two clear points. Point-a-rally to 11 points for best of 3 games will be used for semi-finals and finals.
- (9) Match Balls:** Dunlop (double yellow dot) balls will be used during the tournament. Players may use their own racket or borrow from the Organiser.
- (10) Prizes:** Trophies will be awarded to the Champion, 1st Runner-up, 2nd Runner-up, 3rd Runner-up of each group.
- (11) Enrollment:** Players shall enroll at the University Sports Centre in person by filling in the Entry Form and paying HK\$50 deposit (which will be refunded on the match day). Enrollment shall be first-come-first-served.
- (12) Entry Deadline:** Wednesday, 25th September 2019 at 5:00pm.
- (13) Referee:** The tournament organizer will arrange referee for each match.
- (14) Appeal:** The decisions of the referee will be final. Appeal to the Organiser will not be entertained
- (15) Fixture Ballot:** The draw for the tournament will be held on Wednesday, 25th September 2019, 6:00pm at the Squash Centre. Players are welcome to attend. Fixture will be posted at the University Sports Centre notice board. No re-scheduling is permitted. Any player who fails to turn up 5 minutes after the official commencement time will be regarded as withdrawal from the tournament.
- (16) Dress Code:** Players must put on sports clothing and non-marking rubber-sole sports shoes (not in black).
- (17) Safety:** Players must wear goggles provided by the organizer to protect their eyes.
Players shall ensure safety of themselves and their opponents, such as:
(a) Stop playing when feeling not good. (b) Don't obstruct your opponent's fair view and striking of the ball. (c) Ask for "LET" when being obstructed. Obstructed player will be awarded a "LET" or a "STROKE" according to the referee decision.
