(7) Rules: The tournament will be conducted according to rules and regulations approved

by the Hong Kong Table Tennis Association unless otherwise specified.

a)Single Knockout (8) System of Play:

> b)The best of three games (11 points each game) shall be adopted for the preliminary rounds. While on the other hand, the best of five games shall be

adopted for the second round (best 32) and onwards.

(9)Official Ball: Double Fish V40+ (3 stars) table tennis ball, white in colour. Trophy will be awarded to the winner, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> runner-up. (10)Prize:

(11)Enrollment: Entry can be made in person at the counter of University Sports Centre with

\$50 deposit on a first-come-first-served basis. Deposit will be refunded after

the matches except abstention.

(12)Enrollment Period: From 4 September, 2018 (9:00a.m.) to 5 October, 2018 (5:00p.m.)

Players are required to organize an umpire on their own (or without umpire). (13)Referee:
