(8) System: i) Single Knockout System. (If the number of participants is 4 to 7, the competition

will use round-robin system)

ii) All matches except finals: First player to win 4 games is winner.

iii) Final matches: First player to win 6 games is champion.

iv) No deuce; When the score is 40-40, the receiver chooses the receiving position;

who get this point, who win this game.

v) The players shall change ends at the end of the first, third and every subsequent

odd game of each set.

(9)Official Ball: Organizer will provide tennis ball for the competition.

(10)Prizes : Trophy will be presented to the champions, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd runners-ups.

(11)Entries : i) Apply at **University Sports Centre**.

ii) Deposit of \$100 is required.

(Deposit will be refunded after the matches if no walk-over)

(12) Application Deadline: 27th September 2018 (Thu. 12:00noon)

(13) Umpire : Players are required to serve as umpire.
